



The Sundeck 580 is a motor yacht in an “expedition / trawler” style built by the Italian shipyard Sundeck Yachts. It is conceived as a “villa at sea”: generous interior and exterior spaces, large windows, walk-around side decks, and ample sun pad areas.

The flybridge features a C-shaped settee, convertible table, and amenities for outdoor living.

Below decks, the layout can vary: from 2 up to 4 cabins, with 2 or 3 bathrooms. The interiors are customizable (choice of light or dark woods).

The hull design is semi-displacement with an “axe bow”, which helps with wave penetration and stability.

In terms of performance, the yacht can reach a top speed of about 25 knots and offers efficient cruising with a declared range of ~1,200 nautical miles at 9.5 knots.

Also, standard equipment includes zero-speed gyro stabilizers to improve comfort when at anchor or at low speed.
